RESOLUTION

The Executive Committee of the Delhi High Court Bar Association (DHCBA) in its emergent meeting held on 13.07.2026, has unanimously resolved to abstain from work on 14.07.2026, in light of the view of the Hon'ble Full Court of the Delhi High Court with respect to the enhancement of the pecuniary jurisdiction of the District Courts in Delhi from Rs. 2 crores to Rs. 10 crores, in spite of a strong opposition from the Delhi High Court Bar Association (DHCBA).

The Executive Committee arrived at the above decision after duly noting the serious adverse consequences likely to be faced by the members of the Delhi High Court Bar Association.

The Executive Committee is of the view that the proposed enhancement would have far-reaching ramifications on the justice delivery system and would 'also substantially affect the practice, livelihood and professional interests of a large number of members of the Delhi High Court Bar Association. It is to be noted that the enhancement would result in reduction of the Original Side of this Hon'ble Court by nearly 70% of the cases.

Accordingly, it has been resolved to call for abstention from work on 14.07.2026.

All members are requested to extend their full cooperation and solidarity in the collective interest of the Bar.
